LA's Homelessness ACTION PLANS!

With the 2016 passage of Proposition HHH (to build supportive housing) and H (to provide services) the voters of Los Angeles recognized that more must be done to address the growing numbers of homeless individuals on our streets. Where do plans and actions stand today? Join us to hear **Mike Bonin**, our Westside City Council representative, discuss the status of the City-County strategy to reduce homelessness.



Heidi Marston, Chief Program Officer for LAHSA, will provide the implementation details for planned housing and services. LAHSA partners with nonprofit agencies and the city and county to integrate services and housing options. Outreach workers, such as those working with PPTFH, use LAHSA's Coordinated Entry System to connect homeless individuals to services and housing.
