Report:

- [Reducing Speeding and Making Streets Safer for Pedestrians](#)
 - City Council approved a motion from Councilmember Bonin that directs the Los Angeles Department of Transportation and the Office of the City Attorney to quickly draft an ordinance that reduces speed limits on nearly 200 miles of streets throughout the city.
 - Certain streets, like Sunset Blvd. or Palisades Dr. have local speed limits controlled by state law that prioritized increasing speed limits over pedestrian safety. Recent changes to state law and this motion will help reduce speed limits on certain streets.
 - City Council approved a motion from Councilmember Bonin last week to make permanent pedestrian-safety measures established during the early days of COVID quarantines when parents with young children were eager for safe places for their kids to run or exercise.
 - The City Council also approved a proposal from Councilmember Bonin to give LADOT and LA Metro the authority to use technology to enforce against motorists who illegally park in bus-only lanes.
- Making Streets Safer For Bikers
 - This week, more bike sharing indicators, also known as sharrows, were installed in the Santa Monica Canyon on Entrada Dr. between W. Channel Rd. and Adelaide Pl.
 - These bike sharrows also help connect the San Vicente Bike Path with the Marvin Braude Bike Trail on the beach.
- Safety Improvement Being Made to Wooden Guardrail Along Will Rogers State Park Road
 - Working with community members in the nearby area, our office coordinated the replacement of two missing sections of the white wooden guard rail along Will Rogers State Park Road.
 - StreetsLA is in the process of adding additional reflectors to the guardrail to increase visibility and improve safety.
- Council District 11 Presented a Certificate to Jimmy Dunne and the Palisades Bocce Club
 - The certificate reads:
