

## Legislation Updates as of 6/17/22 (by C. Spitz)\*

### **Adopted Positions (outcomes pending)**

#### **STAP and LAMC ordinance revisions**

CF 20-1536-S1 (Bd of Pub. Wks) – PPCC opposes  
*Passed in BPW; pending in City Council cmtees (no scheduled hearings)*

#### **Extension of BMO to coastal, non-hillside R-1 properties**

CF 10-1058-S4 (Bonin) – PPCC supports  
*Passed in City Council 2020 (awaiting ordinance drafting; no action despite PPCC requests)*

#### **By-right siting of homeless shelters on certain properties in R-1 zones**

CF 22-0158-S4 (Bonin) – PPCC opposes (“requests for consideration” motion also passed in WRAC)  
*Passed in City Council cmtees (pending City Council vote; no scheduled hearing)*

#### **Vehicle dwelling**

CF 14-1057-S9 (Buscaino) – PPCC & WRAC support  
*Pending in City Council cmtee (no scheduled hearing)*

#### **Ban on bicycle “chop shops” in PROW**

CF 21-1115 (Buscaino) – PPCC & WRAC support  
*Passed in City Council (pending final vote on ordinance 6/21)*

#### **Ban on encampments in PROW near libraries**

CF 20-1376-S3 (Buscaino) – on PPCC 6/23/22 agenda for action  
*Pending in City Council cmtee (no scheduled hearing)*

#### **Ban on encampments in PROW near schools/daycares**

CF 20-1376-S1 (Martinez) – PPCC & WRAC support prior/similar Buscaino motion (CF 21-0929)  
*Passed in City Council (awaiting ordinance drafting & final vote)*

#### **Public housing/proposed repeal of Art. 34 of the CA Constitution**

SCA 2 (Allen) – PPCC & WRAC support  
*Passed in Senate May 2022 (pending in Assembly)*

#### **Use idle “big box” sites for low-middle income housing**

SB 15 (Portantino) – PPCC & WRAC support  
*Passed in Senate June 2021 (pending in Assembly) – Allen voted Aye*

**Bill “Watch” (for possible future consideration/action)**

**State:**

**Expand CEQA exemptions for specified “sustainable” transit/bicycle/pedestrian projects; extend prior sunset date of 2023 to 2030**

SB 922 (Wiener)

*Passed in Senate May 2022 (pending in Assembly) – Allen voted Aye*

*Opposed by Sierra Club; supported by League of CA Cities*

**Related:** CF 22-0002-S42 (Bonin) – Resolution to support SB 922 (pending in Council Rules Cmtee)

**ADUs & Jr. ADUs – numerous changes to existing state law preempting local regulations (height limit, owner occupancy, parking, etc.)**

SB 897 (Wieckowski)

*Passed in Senate May 2022 ((pending in Assembly) – Allen voted Aye*
