From Malibu Pacific Palisades Chamber of Commerce:

The Malibu Chamber of Commerce and Pacific Palisades Chamber of Commerce have merged as of July 2022 and are now the Malibu Pacific Palisades Chamber of Commerce.

As you are aware, the PPCC closed its doors in November of 2021 and a merger was set in progress following many discussions. We also conferred with many other chambers who have done the same and we received much encouraged to move forward. Many small chambers struggle to cover the cost of a full time CEO, support staff, an office, insurance and utility costs, and the constant care needed for attention to members, newsletters, accounting, taxes, business requirements, education, event production and constantly changing advocacy needs.

After much deliberation we decided to move forward. We do have a central location to meet for in person Board meetings, and we will be looking for offices in Palisades and Malibu.

Currently we have 375 members in the Malibu area and @150 members in the Palisades.

We are currently offering the Palisades members a temporary courtesy membership and plan on having a Grand Reception that will be free for Palisades members to welcome them into the new chamber. We are beginning monthly Business Breakfasts and Lunch and Learns, as well as evening networking mixers.

We plan on continuing past traditions and on creating new memorable events to support the community and further commerce. We also would like to continue the Honorary Mayors tradition.
