



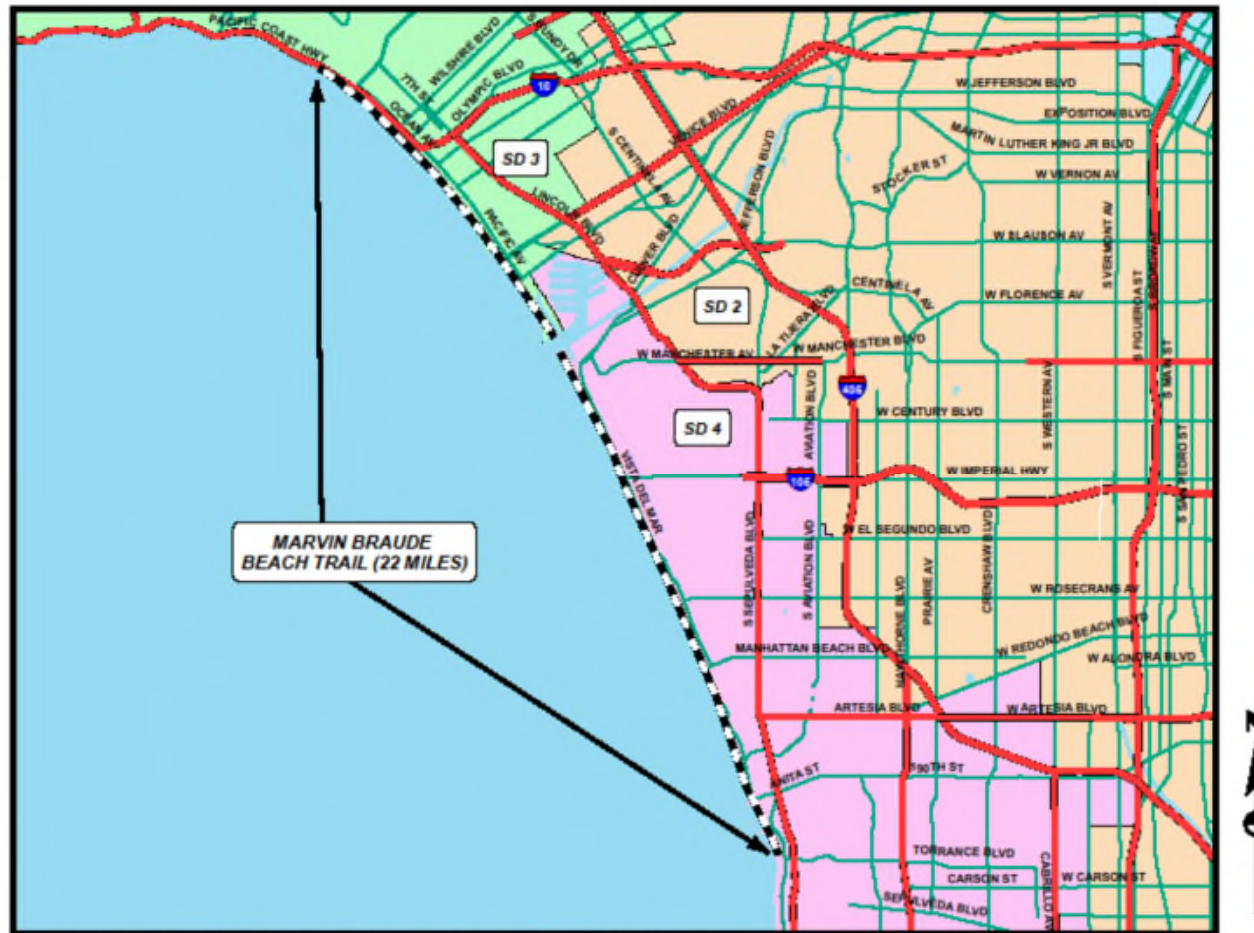

Marvin Braude Beach Trail Gap Closure

- The Marvin Braude Beach Trail is a 22-mile long path along the Pacific Ocean coastline that stretches from Will Rogers Parking Lot (Los Angeles) to Torrance County Beach
- Trail goes through the community of Marina Del Rey and the cities of Los Angeles, Santa Monica, El Segundo, Manhattan Beach, Hermosa Beach, and Torrance
- The existing path is used by more than 5 million users in the summer time for walking, jogging, and riding bicycles

Project Goals

- Close the 0.6 mile gap from Pacific Palisades to Santa Monica which will create a 6-mile continuous pedestrian walkway to Venice
- Widen the existing path from the existing 12 to 14 feet wide to two 12 to 14-foot paths and create two separate and exclusive paths accommodating both pedestrians and bicycle users
