Re: George Wolfberg Park at Potrero Canyon (Park) – Lateral Trail Funding Request

City officials:

The Pacific Palisades Community Council (PPCC) Executive Committee supports the improvement of the existing dirt road connecting the mouths of Potrero and Temescal Canyons (and their two parks) as a pedestrian recreation trail (Lateral Trail). There is a crossing light at PCH & Temescal Canyon Road, for a safe crossing to Will Rogers State Beach for users of the new Park.

In order to further Park completion, if there is no current funding for the Lateral Trail, we request that the City immediately apply for federal funding via the "community projects" funding program administered through Congressman Lieu's office: <https://lieu.house.gov/helping-you/community-project-funding-requests>.

Please note that pursuant to PPCC Bylaws, after a straw poll was taken at the regular PPCC Board meeting on March 24, 2022, the full PPCC Board indicated approval of this request to be submitted by the PPCC Executive Committee.
