Neighborhood Updates

- 1. There will be sidewalk repair and driveway approach construction work on **1367 Palisades**Dr. The Construction Services Division will be installing new sidewalk and driveway approaches starting the weekend of Saturday, July 30th, 2022 at this location. A lane may be closed at times to remove and replace new sidewalk and driveway approaches. Temporary no parking signs may be posted so repairs can be made.
- 2. **Recent mountain lion sightings have been reported**, here are some safety tips in case you encounter one:
 - a. Stay calm. Avoid making any sudden movements.
 - b. Move back from the mountain lion if it has not yet spotted you.
 - c. Mountain lions will sometimes attack if cornered, so if it has spotted you give it room to escape.
 - d. Keep sight of the mountain lion.
 - e. Expand your profile by waving your arms or using your clothes.
 - f. Do not turn away or bend over to pick up anything. That opening will invite the animal to attack.
 - g. Do not leave pets out unattended in the yard in the evenings.
 - h. Living with Mountain Lions
 - Deer-proof your property to avoid attracting a lion's main food source.
 - Remove dense vegetation from around the home to reduce hiding spaces.
 - Install outdoor lighting to make it difficult for mountain lions to approach unseen.
 - Secure livestock and outdoor large pets in sturdy, covered shelters at night. Bring all pets you can into the home at night.
 - Always remember Mountain lions are wild animals and their behavior may be unpredictable (like any wildlife). DO NOT RUN. Stay calm. Do not turn your back. Face the animal, make noise and try to look bigger.

 - a. The Greek Theatre along with the City of Los Angeles, Department of Recreation and Parks (RAP) has created an exciting opportunity for communities throughout Los Angeles for youth to experience one of the city's most treasured and historical music venues.
 - b.  - d. Entries will be accepted beginning June 13th, 2022 through August 15th, 2022.
