

Overhead Power Pole Inspections

Pacific Palisades Area August – October 2023

Inspection Process

- Detailed "In-Depth Visual" inspection to be performed -Ensures Safety & Reliability
- Detailed Inspections are completed every 3 years
- Approximately 4,000 power poles in the Pacific Palisades will be inspected

Detailed inspections "shall be defined as a careful visual inspection of Electrical facilities and structures using inspection tools such as binoculars and measuring devices, as appropriate."

-- General Order 95, Rule 80.1A

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Inspection Details

- Power pole condition and identification tags
- Electrical and communication equipment/conductors
- Transformers, cross-arms, insulators and wires

What to Expect

- Osmose crews will be in the area for approximately two months
- Inspecting one pole takes ~15-30 minutes
- Inspection set up is minimal

 no traffic impacts or lane
 closures anticipated
- No anticipated power outages

- Inspectors will use binoculars, cameras, and other tools
- LADWP crews may follow up to perform repairs as needed – more info to come





Poles Located on Private Property

Inspector will knock on the resident's door to request access.

Feel free to ask:

- Osmose identification badge
- Approved LADWP Contractor decal on vehicle
- To speak to LADWP Representative

A door hanger will be left if there is no answer

Inspectors will never request to enter/walk through a house
