INVESTIGATE consumer complaints.







Resources to Help You Achieve Financial Security



... be suspicious ...

the caller or sender may not be who they say they are.





#### What Can You Do?

- Never give personal information unless YOU initiated the contact
  - Don't return phone calls left on voice message
  - Unknown calls/numbers Don't answer or Hang up!
- GOVERNMENT AGENCIES DO NOT CALL
- Don't click on links sent via text/email
- Bypass using your PIN with a Debit card (skimmers)
- Use Anti-Fraud Pen for Check Writers
- Monitor & Freeze Your Credit
- Log out not X out of websites
- Verify there is an issue.. GO TO THE SOURCE YOURSELF
