In light of the factors raised during our Special Meeting of May 20th and the inherent concerns that come with being a hillside neighborhood entirely within the Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFHSZ) with very few major arteries of ingress and egress, PPCC supports the appeal by Castellammare Mesa Home Owners of the adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Tramonto Project. We insist that the City Council require a full and Environmental Impact Report (EIR), performed independently by a responsible geologist that us approved by the City. We also ask that the City of LA prioritize the stabilization of the Tramonto Slide as part of its mandate to protect the public's safety - partnering with the County and the State if need be to accomplish that goal. We acknowledge that a serious public controversy concerning the environmental effect of the project may exist and we ask that the City insist on an independent EIR.
