Upcoming Deadlines to Apply for Disaster Recovery Help

LOS ANGELES – Several deadlines are approaching for individuals impacted by the Los Angeles Wildfires.

- **FEMA Individual Assistance: March 10, 2025**

Apply online at DisasterAssistance.gov, by calling FEMA's helpline at **800-621-3362**, or by using the [FEMA mobile app](#). If you use a relay service, such as video relay (VRS), captioned telephone or other service, give FEMA the number for that service. You may also apply at a Disaster Recovery Center. Visit the [DRC Locator](#) for a center near you.

- **SBA Disaster Loan: March 10, 2025**

Apply for a Small Business Administration Disaster Loan online at <https://lending.sba.gov> or call SBA at **800-659-2955**. Individuals who are deaf or hard-of-hearing may call **800-877-8339**.

- **FEMA Public Assistance: March 9, 2025**

Local governments and private nonprofit organizations (PNPs), including houses of worship and other faith-based organizations may file a Request for Public Assistance (RPA) online at the **FEMA Grants Portal** at grantee.fema.gov, and click on "Register your Organization and Request Public Assistance" (at bottom of opening page). Fill in the requested information.

- **The Government-run Debris Removal Program Right of Entry form: March 31, 2025**
