Grants Committee Recommendation – Palisades Village Green Committee

The PPCC Grants Committee is pleased to recommend a grant of \$10,817 from donations that PPCC has received to the Palisades Village Green Committee (PVGC), for the installation of a new Water Hydration Station at the Village Green.

The PVGC is an all-volunteer nonprofit organization formed in 1972, which since that time has maintained the small community park – the Palisades Village Green – in the center of the Palisades business district. As the PVGC explains:

". . . [the PVGC's] mission is to maintain in the heart of the community an attractive comfortable space in which people can meet others, have a snack or simply sit in the shade to read or relax. The park directly benefits the community as a green space with a fountain, a drinking fountain, bus stop and space for community events and socialization."

The Palisades Village Green sustained damage during the Fire and the PVGC is seeking to restore the overall green space as well as items that were destroyed or damaged, including seeking funds for the installation of a new Hydration Station that will provide a water bottle filling station, drinking fountain and dog bowl. The Grants Committee is delighted to recommend a grant to provide this useful public amenity that will no doubt be greatly appreciated by visitors to the Palisades Village Green.

In helping to enhance the community amenities offered at the Palisades Village Green, this grant would support the goal of overall Palisades Fire Recovery. The Grants Committee urges the PPCC Board to approve a \$10,817 grant to PVGC for the purpose described above.
