- 8am** **Coffee & Breakfast** Public Gathering - American Legion Post 283
- 9-10am** **A private white glove presentation of flags** for the families of those lost and for invited guests. Special invocation and accompanying music by the **Palisades symphony. Program steamed live** immediately outside Post 283 on La Cruz Drive for public viewing.
- 10-10:20am** **Dedication** of the American Legion Post 283 “**survivor flag**” flown during the fire to be preserved. Retirement of Palisades Post Office flag and raising of replacement flag. Accompanying bugler.
- 10:20am** **Color guard and procession** to the Village Green, located on Sunset Blvd., featuring representatives from the American Legion, the Army National Guard, U.S. Army Corp of Engineers, and select relief organizations. Accompanying bagpipers.
- 10:30-11am** **Ringling of the bells**, wreath presentations, and moment of remembrance on the Village Green honoring those lost.
- 11:15-1pm** **Community Lunch** at Palisades American Post 283
