

Grants Committee Recommendation – Palisades High School Boys Baseball

The PPCC Grants Committee is pleased to recommend a grant of **\$5,000** from donations that PPCC has received to the Pacific Palisades High School Boys Baseball Program for expenses related to disruptions caused by the fire.

This grant is similar to one recently made by PPCC to the Palisades High School Girls Softball Program for \$5,000. The baseball and softball programs are the only athletic programs that have indefinitely lost access to their on-campus game and practice facility.

Since the fire, the baseball field at Palisades High School has been “removed” and replaced with temporary classrooms. As a result, the baseball program must travel elsewhere to play and practice, incurring additional expenses. In addition to the traditional spring competitive season, the baseball program operates year-round with programs such as fall development and winter conditioning. The grant will help pay for the fall development programming and for practice facilities for both the fall and spring seasons. Specific expenses include field rental and practice facility costs, equipment replacement, and bullpen and batting cage access.

The grant recommended by the PPCC Grants Committee helps the Palisades High Baseball Program continue to operate as the program rebuilds.
