



PPCC 2026 Election FAQ

How can I vote?

Starting at 8 AM on August 21, go to <https://pacpalicc.org> and click “VOTE” to access and cast your electronic ballot. Electronic voting through the PPCC website is the only way to vote. Voting ends at 8 PM on September 4.

If I have more than one person who is eligible to vote in my household, do we each cast our own votes? Yes.

Each eligible voter (those in your household who are at least 18 years old when voting ends) should fill out their own ballot and cast their own independent vote(s).

I don't know what Area I live in. How can I find out?

You may find the area for your address on the PPCC website at <https://pacpalicc.org/index.php/area-maps/>. You will also be able to link to the Area Maps tab from the electronic ballot.

Am I eligible to vote if I evacuated after the fire and I'm still living temporarily at a different address outside of the Palisades?

Yes. You may vote for Area Representative and At-large Representative as set forth in Article III.K of the [PPCC Bylaws](#), *if you intend to return to your Principal Residence address in Pacific Palisades (as of January 7, 2025), or to another address in Pacific Palisades as your permanent principal residence.* The ballot will ask for that address to be listed and will include a statement for you to affirm your intent to return.

Can property owners (non-primary resident) and business operators vote in the elections as well?

Yes. Property owners and business operators can also participate in the election and vote for the At-large Representative, i.e., you don't have to be a resident to vote for the At-large Representative. If you are a non-resident property owner or a business operator in any area of Pacific Palisades, you may advance to the At-large Representative page on the ballot and submit your vote. You may also vote if your business was destroyed but you intend to return to and re-open it in Pacific Palisades.

May I vote for At-large Representative as well as my Area Representative?

Yes. You may vote for the Area representative in the area in which your Principal Residence is located, *and* you may vote for At-large Representative. You may also choose to vote for one seat and not the other.

If I vote for Area representative and don't wish to vote for an At-large candidate, can I still submit my ballot?

Yes, you may vote for your Area Rep, skip the At-large Representative portion and advance to the end.

Similarly, if I don't wish to vote for Area Representative, but I'm a resident who wants to vote for the At-Large Representative, is that possible?

Yes. You may advance through the ballot until you get to the At-large Representative candidates, cast your vote, and then submit your ballot.

What if I don't have a computer? How can I vote?

You may vote from a cell phone or iPad. If you don't have any devices, please email info@pacpalicc.org for help in time to get assistance well in advance of the 8 PM voting deadline on September 4, 2026.

If the candidate for my area is running unopposed, why should I vote?

PPCC encourages everyone to view the candidate statements and get to know the individuals who will represent them (<https://pacpalicc.org/wp-content/uploads/2026/07/PPCC-Area-Rep-Candidates-2026.pdf>). PPCC believes that it's important to participate, be engaged in the electoral process at every level, and support fellow Palisadians!
