Re: SB 1093 (Allen); Request for Governor's Signature

Dear Governor Newsom:

Pacific Palisades Community Council (PPCC) – representing the community that suffered massive and unprecedented destruction from the Palisades fire in January 2025 – strongly supports SB 1093 (Allen / protection of mobile home park residents' rights *post-disaster*).

As explained in PPCC's original letter, two such parks (Palisades Bowl and Tahitian Terrace) were destroyed during the devastating fire. SB 1903 offers essential protections to help safeguard these affordable housing elements in our area and protect valued neighborhoods from displacement after the fire, by providing greater rights, certainty and transparency to mobile home residents in the wake of a disaster.

We respectfully urge you to sign SB 1903 into law.
